Why take this class? So you can respond to the most common self-defense situations. This class allows you the opportunity to understand, develop and practice the necessary skills. For example:

How close should you be to the target before you shoot?

What if you are being pursued as you run?

What if your gun jams?

What if you have to reload quickly?

Who should take this class? Any gun owner who carries a firearm for either CCW or for their job. (Armed security and Private Investigators)

What will you learn? You will learn these shooting techniques: rapid reloading, one-arm shooting (left arm and right arm), malfunction drills, half-turns and full turns, and close quarter battle (CQB), Shoot on the move. You will shoot 500 rounds at life-size silhouettes and metal targets.

What You Need to Bring to the Intermediate Pistol Class

Gun:	<i>Your own</i> pistol, any caliber. It must be in good working order.
For Reloading:	For a semi-automatic, you will need at least two additional magazines with a belt pouch.
Holster:	Whatever holster you are currently using is required for the class. (IWB or Duty)
Belt:	You will need a good quality belt on which to hold the holster and speed loaders/magazines. Tip: Be sure to wear pants that have belt loops that the belt fits.
Protection:	Prescription glasses, shooting glasses are required, along with hearing protection. <i>Eye and ear protection will not be provided</i>
